Please be advised that role assignment has begun. Your contact information is being forwarded to an appropriate department with the Jamboree, usually based on your selection at registration, but sometimes based on where the Jamboree is most in need of help. More details about your assignment for the Jamboree will then be provided personally by someone from that department, likely before April, 2007.

## OOS SUBCAMP

Dave Gagen, OOS Subcamp Chief, and his team are busy preparing to make your stay at CJ as memorable for you as you will help make it for our youth participants. Although only limited services will be available, the Subcamp will have a gathering area for nightly socializing, water available and a full team to work with you. It is also rumoured that there will be a coffee stand very close by where you may purchase coffee and snacks at any time.

## ACCOMMODATIONS

Tenting spaces are available to OOS at no extra cost. Basic water and portable toilets will be available at the OOS Subcamp.

Please note that we will be offering accommodation in the form of a bed in a caboose- yes, a real train caboose! This is for those who wish to live in a dormitory-style

building at the Jamboree. Each caboose will house 10 OOS (we have a total of 50 places available) and provides basic facilities including bunk beds, lights, and a small gathering area. These spots will be rented on a first come, first served basis at the cost of \$40 for the entire Jamboree (\$5/night), with the monies going back to Camp Tamaracouta for future development projects. If you decide on this option, please have the fee paid by April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

A very limited number of trailer spaces are available. These spaces will have NO services provided (water, electricity, or sewer) and ALL vehicles (the ones towing the trailers) will be parked offsite at the OOS parking area some 1.7 kms from the site. A scheduled shuttle will operate throughout the week to get OOS to their vehicles if required.

### MEAL PLAN

You have indicated with your registration whether or not you will be taking advantage of the fantastic Meal Plan provided for the OOS. We will continue to work with our food providers to ensure quality meals for those selecting the meal plan. ### OOS FEE

Part of your registration fee of \$50.00 covers an OOS necker and Jamboree crest. Through a generous donation you will also be provided with a CJ'07 woggle. As in the past, the Trading Post, which will be open for OOS only on Tuesday July 24<sup>th</sup>, will carry a full range of Jamboree souvenirs for you to purchase along with many other camping needs.

### INDABA

CJ'07 will boast a fantastic program of training sessions each evening for OOS. Sign up sheets will be placed in the X-Centre for these sessions. We are sure that you will find one that interests you.

### TRANSPORTATION

Pick up for those OOS arriving by train, bus or airplane will be arranged only after you have contacted the Jamboree Office with detailed travel plans. Watch for future details regarding these travel plans.
