CJ Update

The Board of Governor have given approval to proceed with CJ 07.

To date confirmed number of participants is 5437, and 700 offer of service.

Number of participants is down to what was anticipated but registration is not yet closed.

With lower number the budget will be adjusted and this will affect all subcamps.

Quebec is having difficulties finding OOS to help in running their sub camp and will not be hosting a sub camp, this could increase the number of units per sub camp. Since we seem to be doing all right with OSS is there any one willing to help out at other sub camps if needed?

Bill and Randy will be at camp Saturday July 21 and will be looking for a small crew who can be there early to help clear and clean the site. All sub camp staff should be at CJ by Monday July 23. OSS meal plan does not start until Monday July 23noon.

Participants will start to arrive on Tuesday July 24, although it is anticipated that the bulk of arrivals will be Wednesday. The first unit meal plan begins Wednesday at noon, opening ceremonies at 8:00 pm on Wednesday and programming starts on Thursday July 26.
